## • Itinerary

### Day 1 Guangzhou Arrival

Airport pick-up according to flight schedule and transfer to hotel. Rest after arrival.

Meal: In-flight meal

Accommodation: Yi Zhi Hotel, Taikoo Li, Zhujiang New Town, Guangzhou or similar

### Day 2 Guangzhou

Visit **Huacheng Square**, the modern city center of Guangzhou, followed by the **Guangzhou New Cultural Center**. Continue to **Yongqingfang**, a historic district blending traditional Lingnan architecture with modern culture. In the evening, enjoy a **Pearl River night cruise**, offering scenic views of Guangzhou's skyline.

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: Yi Zhi Hotel, Taikoo Li, Zhujiang New Town, Guangzhou or similar

### Day 3 Guangzhou

Experience the popular **Haizhu Tram Line** along the riverside. Visit **Xiaomanyao (Canton Tower)** for photo opportunities, continue to **Chen Clan Ancestral Hall**, famous for its traditional Guangdong architecture, then explore **Beijing Road Pedestrian Street** and visit **Dafo Temple**, one of Guangzhou's historic Buddhist temples.

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: Yi Zhi Hotel, Taikoo Li, Zhujiang New Town, Guangzhou or similar

### Day 4 Guangzhou / Foshan

Visit **Foshan Ancestral Temple**, a landmark of Lingnan culture. Continue to **Lingnan Tiandi**, a cultural and commercial district with restored historic buildings. Explore **Fengjian Water Town**, known for its canals and traditional village scenery, then visit **Qinghui Garden**, a classical Lingnan garden, and stroll along **Huagai Road Pedestrian Street**.

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: Yi Zhi Hotel, Taikoo Li, Zhujiang New Town, Guangzhou or similar

### Day 5 Guilin

Visit **Lingnan Impression Park** to experience traditional Cantonese folk culture. Transfer to the railway station and take the **high-speed train from Guangzhou to Guilin (about 2-3 hours)**. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel and enjoy free time.

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: Versailles Hotel (Guilin Two Rivers and Four Lakes Railway Station Branch) or similar

## Day 6 Longji

Visit **Elephant Trunk Hill**, the symbol of Guilin's landscape. Continue to **Longji Rice Terraces**, famous for its breathtaking layered rice fields and ethnic minority villages.

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: Tianyuan Homestay (Longji Rice Terraces Jiulong Wuhu Viewing Platform Branch) or similar

## Day 7 Guilin

Early morning visit to **Longji Rice Terraces** to view the sunrise (subject to weather conditions). Continue to **Nine Dragons and Five Tigers Viewpoint** for panoramic terrace scenery, then visit **Diecai Hill** and **Shan Lake** in Guilin city.

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: Versailles Hotel (Guilin Two Rivers and Four Lakes Railway Station Branch) or similar

## Day 8 Yangshuo

Take a **Li River cruise (3-star boat)** to enjoy the classic karst landscape along the river. Visit **Xingping Ancient Town**, known as the filming location of the 20 RMB note background. Continue to **Silver Cave**, a famous limestone cave with impressive stalactite formations, then enjoy free time at **West Street** in Yangshuo.

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: Wukesong International Hotel (Lijiang Branch, Yangshuo West Street) or similar

## Day 9 Guilin

Enjoy a **Yulong River bamboo rafting experience (two persons per raft)**, followed by visits to **Shiwai Taoyuan (Peach Blossom Land)** and **Xianggong Mountain**, known for its scenic mountain views and photography spots.

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: Versailles Hotel (Guilin Two Rivers and Four Lakes Railway Station Branch) or similar

## Day 10 Departure

Transfer to the airport according to the designated time. End of the journey.

Meals: Breakfast

\*This itinerary is for reference only; the final version is subject to the tour confirmation notice. The travel agency reserves the right to adjust the order of visits.

\*Departures from other cities will require an additional airfare surcharge.

1. No tour guide service is provided for airport or train station transfers. Vehicles may vary depending on availability.
2. No tour guide service is provided during the cruise.
3. Driver and guide service is limited to 8 working hours per day. Overtime will be charged at RMB 100 per person per hour for both the driver and the guide. Airport and train station transfers are excluded from this rule.
4. Entrance tickets include only the first admission ticket to the listed attractions. Longji Terrace shuttle transportation is at guests' own expense. For Yulong River bamboo rafting, the pier is not designated and is subject to arrangement.
5. Prices during public holidays (Labor Day, National Day, Chinese New Year) and peak seasons (summer and winter holidays) are subject to adjustment.  
Summer holiday: June – end of August  
Winter holiday: January – end of February

## ◆ METHODS OF PAYMENT

To proceed with reservations, a deposit is required. All services remain subject to availability until payment is received and confirmations are completed.

### Booking & Payment Terms

Explore2Go Travels offers a **three-instalment payment** plan as outlined below:

1. **Deposit – 50% per person**

A deposit of 50% per person is required at the time of booking to secure the arrangements.

2. **Second Payment – 30%**

30% of the total package price is payable within one (1) month after the airline tickets have been issued.

3. **Final Balance – 20%**

The remaining 20% must be paid no later than thirty (30) days prior to the departure date.

All bookings will be confirmed upon receipt of the required payments. Payment deadlines must be observed to ensure all services remain secured.

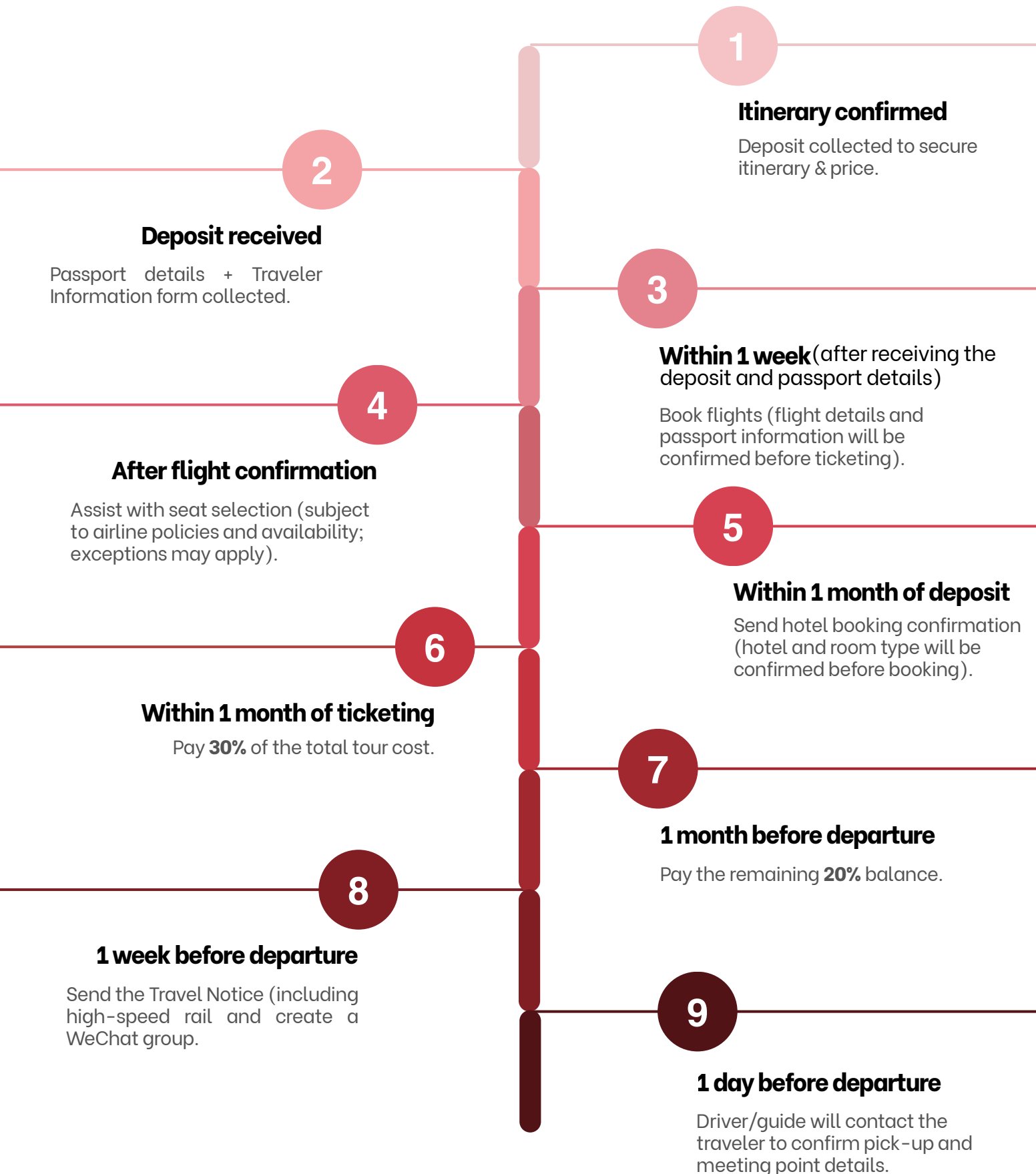
### Cancellation & Amendment Policy

- We support a flexible cancellation and amendment policy.
- For China itineraries, once hotel reservations have been confirmed, hotel payments become non-refundable in the event of cancellation.
- Airfares, High-Speed Train tickets, and local transportation fees are subject to the respective airline or service provider's cancellation and amendment policies. Refunds, if applicable, will be processed accordingly.
- Cancellations made within one month prior to departure are non-refundable.

## ◆ BOOKING & SERVICE PROCESS

If the departure date is **within 6 months**, the following process will apply.

If the departure date is **more than 6 months** away, we will update and confirm arrangements in stages based on the booking windows for flights and hotels.



## ◆ AIRFARE & FLIGHT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### Airline Selection

**Flights will be arranged based on the overall itinerary and pricing considerations.**

The selected airline may be either a full-service carrier or a low-cost carrier. If you have specific requests such as a preferred airline, upgrade to Premium Economy or Business Class, or seat selection, we will make every effort to accommodate your request; however, all arrangements are subject to final confirmation by the airline.

Flights may not be direct and may include up to two (2) stopovers.

### Ticket Cancellation & Amendment Policy

**Once issued, air tickets are non-refundable.**

Any changes to the itinerary must comply with the airline's regulations, and any applicable fees charged by the airline must be borne by the passenger.

### Passenger Information

Please ensure that all passenger names exactly match the passport, including all middle names.

If any name correction is required due to incorrect information provided, any **applicable name change fee (AUD 150)**, additional airline charges, or the cost of reissuing a new ticket shall be borne by the passenger.

### Flight Changes

**Flight schedule changes or cancellations made by the airline are beyond our control.** Any additional expenses resulting from such changes (including extended layovers, rebooking fees, or additional accommodation costs) shall be borne by the passenger.

## ◆ BAGGAGE POLICY

- **International Flights:** Each passenger is entitled to **20kg of checked baggage** (either one or two pieces, subject to the airline's regulations) plus **7kg of carry-on baggage**.
- **Domestic Flights:** **Only one** piece of checked baggage is included. Any excess baggage charges must be borne by the passenger.
- It is recommended that each passenger's total baggage weight does not exceed 20kg.
- Passengers are responsible for handling their own luggage throughout the journey. Porter service is not included in this itinerary.
