• Itinerary

Day 1 Tokyo

Airport pick-up according to your flight schedule and transfer to the hotel. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to explore nearby areas or relax after arrival.

Accommodation: Shinjuku Washington Hotel or equivalent

Day 2 Tokyo

Visit **Senso-ji Temple**, Tokyo's oldest Buddhist temple and a symbol of traditional Japan. Continue to **Ueno Park**, one of Tokyo's most famous public parks, before exploring **Akihabara**, the center of Japan's anime and gaming culture. Stop for photos at **Tokyo Tower** (exterior view) and finish the day in the elegant shopping district of **Ginza**.

Day 3 Kamakura / Enoshima / Tokyo

Travel to **Kamakura High School Station**, famous as the iconic *Slam Dunk* anime filming location. Ride the nostalgic **Enoden Railway** along the coastline and explore **Komachi Street**, known for its traditional shops and local snacks. Continue to **Enoshima Island** for a relaxing seaside walk and scenic ocean views before returning to Tokyo.

Day 4 Hakone / Fireworks Festival

Depart for **Hakone**, one of Japan's most popular resort areas. Visit **Hakone Shrine**, set among beautiful cedar forests on the shores of Lake Ashi. Continue to **Atami Sun Beach**, known for its scenic coastline and relaxed atmosphere. Explore **Atami Ginza Shopping Street** before attending a spectacular **Summer Fireworks Festival**, one of Japan's most anticipated seasonal events.

Day 5 Kyoto

Take the **Shinkansen (bullet train) to Kyoto**. Visit the famous **Kiyomizu-dera Temple**, offering panoramic views of the city. Stroll through the historic streets of **Sannenzaka and Ninenzaka**, lined with traditional shops and cafés. Continue to **Hanamikoji Street** and the scenic **Kamogawa River**, where you can experience Kyoto's timeless atmosphere. Optional kimono rental experience is available.

Accommodation: Vessel Hotel Campana Kyoto Gojo or equivalent

Day 6 Kyoto / Osaka

Explore **Arashiyama**, one of Kyoto's most scenic districts. Ride the famous **Sagano Romantic Train**, offering beautiful views of the Hozugawa Valley. Visit **Jojakko-ji**

Temple, Tenryu-ji Temple, Togetsukyo Bridge, and enjoy a leisurely walk through **Arashiyama Park** before continuing to Osaka.

Day 7 Nara / Osaka

Take a day trip to **Nara**, Japan's first permanent capital. Visit **Nara Park**, home to hundreds of friendly free-roaming deer. Visit **Nigatsu-do Hall, Kasuga Taisha Shrine**, and enjoy panoramic views from **Wakakusa Mountain** before returning to Osaka.

◆ METHODS OF PAYMENT

To proceed with reservations, a deposit is required. All services remain subject to availability until payment is received and confirmations are completed.

Booking & Payment Terms

Explore2Go Travels offers a **three-instalment payment** plan as outlined below:

1. **Deposit – 50% per person**

A deposit of 50% per person is required at the time of booking to secure the arrangements.

2. **Second Payment – 30%**

30% of the total package price is payable within one (1) month after the airline tickets have been issued.

3. **Final Balance – 20%**

The remaining 20% must be paid no later than thirty (30) days prior to the departure date.

All bookings will be confirmed upon receipt of the required payments. Payment deadlines must be observed to ensure all services remain secured.

Cancellation & Amendment Policy

- Airfares, Shinkansen tickets, and local transportation fees are subject to the respective airline or service provider's cancellation and amendment policies. Refunds, if applicable, will be processed accordingly.
- Cancellations made within one month prior to departure are non-refundable.

◆ BOOKING & SERVICE PROCESS

If the departure date is **within 6 months**, the following process will apply.

If the departure date is **more than 6 months** away, we will update and confirm arrangements in stages based on the booking windows for flights and hotels.



◆ AIRFARE & FLIGHT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Airline Selection

Flights will be arranged based on the overall itinerary and pricing considerations.

The selected airline may be either a full-service carrier or a low-cost carrier. If you have specific requests such as a preferred airline, upgrade to Premium Economy or Business Class, or seat selection, we will make every effort to accommodate your request; however, all arrangements are subject to final confirmation by the airline.

Flights may not be direct and may include up to two (2) stopovers.

Ticket Cancellation & Amendment Policy

Once issued, air tickets are non-refundable.

Any changes to the itinerary must comply with the airline's regulations, and any applicable fees charged by the airline must be borne by the passenger.

Passenger Information

Please ensure that all passenger names exactly match the passport, including all middle names.

If any name correction is required due to incorrect information provided, any **applicable name change fee (AUD 150)**, additional airline charges, or the cost of reissuing a new ticket shall be borne by the passenger.

Flight Changes

Flight schedule changes or cancellations made by the airline are beyond our control. Any additional expenses resulting from such changes (including extended layovers, rebooking fees, or additional accommodation costs) shall be borne by the passenger.

◆ BAGGAGE POLICY

- **International Flights:** Each passenger is entitled to **20kg of checked baggage** (either one or two pieces, subject to the airline's regulations) plus **7kg of carry-on baggage**.
- **Domestic Flights:** **Only one** piece of checked baggage is included. Any excess baggage charges must be borne by the passenger.
- It is recommended that each passenger's total baggage weight does not exceed 20kg.
- Passengers are responsible for handling their own luggage throughout the journey. Porter service is not included in this itinerary.
