• Itinerary

Day 1 Shenyang Arrival

Arrive in Shenyang and transfer to your hotel according to your flight schedule. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure, or explore **Xita Korean Street** to experience the local Korean culture and cuisine.

Meal: In-flight meal

Accommodation: Huaren Shuyu Hotel (Shenyang Qingnian Street Mix City)

Day 2 Shenyang

Visit **Xiaoheyan Morning Market**, one of the city's most popular local markets. Continue to **Shenyang Imperial Palace**, the former royal residence of the early Qing Dynasty, before exploring **Middle Street**, one of China's oldest commercial streets. Visit **Beiling Park**, where you may also choose to experience optional snow activities at your own expense.

Accommodation: Huaren Shuyu Hotel (Shenyang Qingnian Street Mix City)

Day 3 Northeast Asia International Ski Resort

Transfer to **Northeast Asia International Ski Resort** and enjoy a full day of skiing. **Ski pass and cable car are included**, giving you plenty of time to explore the slopes.

Day 4 Northeast Asia International Ski Resort

Day 6 Harbin

Travel from Shenyang to **Harbin** by **Second Class High-Speed Train**. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Accommodation: Manxin Hotel Harbin Railway Station Guogeli Street

Day 7 Harbin

Visit the famous **Saint Sophia Cathedral**, one of Harbin's most recognizable landmarks, before exploring **Central Street**, renowned for its European architecture and lively atmosphere. Continue to **Stalin Park** and the iconic **Flood Control Monument**, then visit the **Chinese Baroque Historic Block**, where East meets West in beautifully preserved streets.

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: Manxin Hotel Harbin Railway Station Guogeli Street

Day 8 Harbin

Enjoy a relaxed morning before spending the afternoon at **Harbin Ice and Snow World**, home to spectacular ice sculptures, illuminated snow buildings, and world-famous winter attractions.

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: Manxin Hotel Harbin Railway Station Guogeli Street

Day 9 Departure

Transfer to the airport according to your flight schedule. End of the journey.

Meals: Breakfast

*Departures from other cities will require an additional airfare surcharge.

1. No tour guide service is provided for airport or train station transfers. Vehicles may vary depending on availability.
2. Driver and guide service is limited to 8 working hours per day. Overtime will be charged at RMB 100 per person per hour for both the driver and the guide. Airport and train station transfers are excluded from this rule.
3. Entrance tickets include only the first admission ticket to the listed attractions. Longji Terrace shuttle transportation is at guests' own expense. For Yulong River bamboo rafting, the pier is not designated and is subject to arrangement.

◆ METHODS OF PAYMENT

To proceed with reservations, a deposit is required. All services remain subject to availability until payment is received and confirmations are completed.

Booking & Payment Terms

Explore2Go Travels offers a **three-instalment payment** plan as outlined below:

1. Deposit – 50% per person

A deposit of 50% per person is required at the time of booking to secure the arrangements.

2. Second Payment – 30%

30% of the total package price is payable within one (1) week after the airline tickets have been issued.

3. Final Balance – 20%

The remaining 20% must be paid no later than seven (7) days prior to the departure date.

All bookings will be confirmed upon receipt of the required payments. Payment deadlines must be observed to ensure all services remain secured.

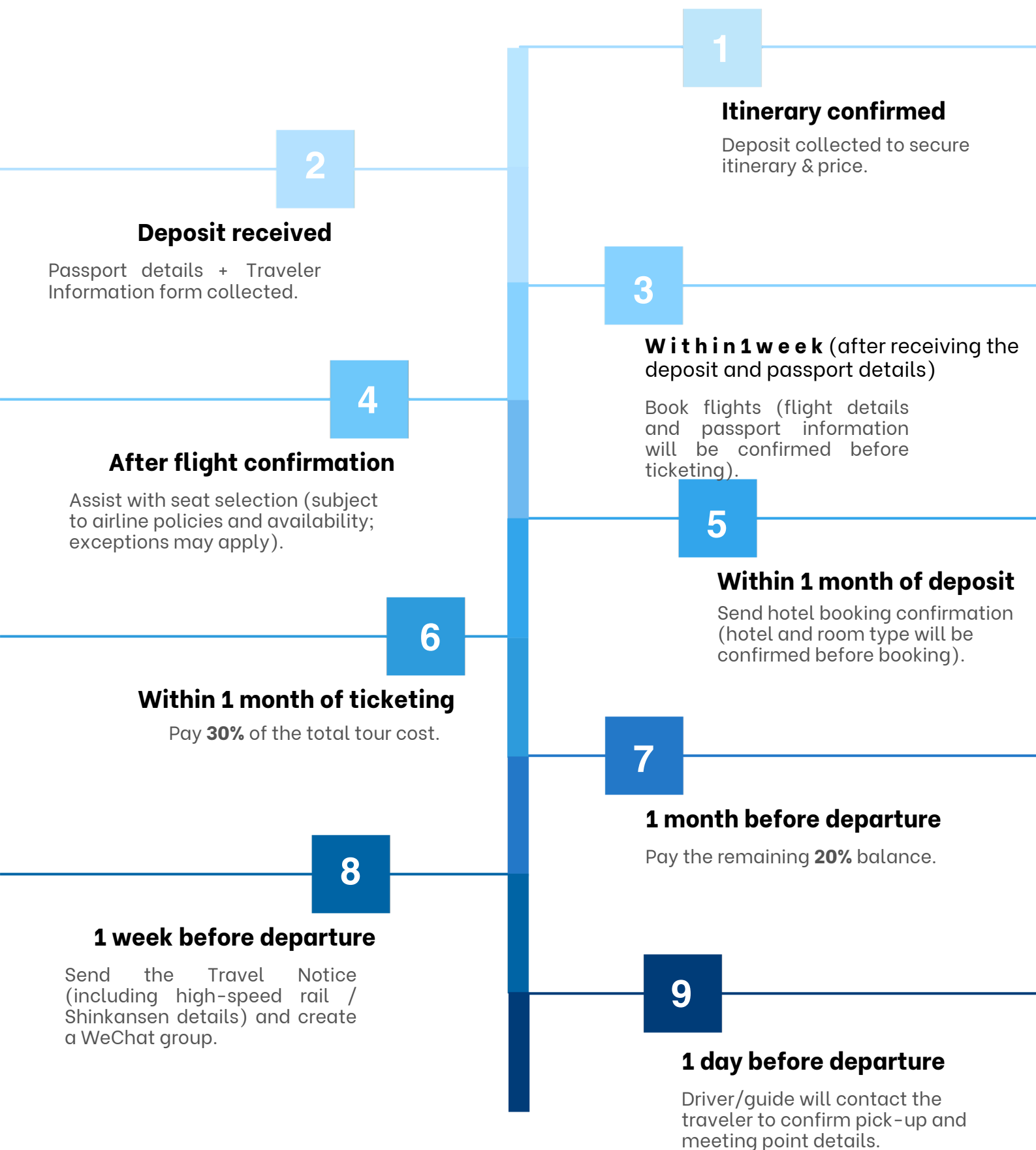

Cancellation & Amendment Policy

- We offer a flexible cancellation and amendment policy.
- For China itineraries, once the hotel reservation has been confirmed, a cancellation will incur a 30% charge of the total amount paid as a cancellation fee.
- Flight tickets will follow the airline's actual cancellation and change policies. Any difference will be refunded or charged accordingly.
- High-speed train tickets: If cancelled more than 8 days before departure, no cancellation fee will be charged. Cancellations within 8 days of departure will follow the official railway refund policy. (Hong Kong routes excluded).
- Cancellations made within 1 month prior to departure are non-refundable. (Except for train and flight tickets which will be refunded according to the applicable cancellation policies.)

◆ BOOKING & SERVICE PROCESS

If the departure date is **within 6 months**, the following process will apply.
If the departure date is **more than 6 months** away, we will update and confirm arrangements in stages based on the booking windows for flights and hotels.



◆ AIRFARE & FLIGHT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Airline Selection

Flights will be arranged based on the overall itinerary and pricing considerations.

The selected airline may be either a full-service carrier or a low-cost carrier. If you have specific requests such as a preferred airline, upgrade to Premium Economy or Business Class, or seat selection, we will make every effort to accommodate your request; however, all arrangements are subject to final confirmation by the airline.

Flights may not be direct and may include up to two (2) stopovers.

Ticket Cancellation & Amendment Policy

Once issued, air tickets are non-refundable.

Any changes to the itinerary must comply with the airline's regulations, and any applicable fees charged by the airline must be borne by the passenger.

Passenger Information

Please ensure that all passenger names exactly match the passport, including all middle names.

If any name correction is required due to incorrect information provided, any **applicable name change fee (AUD 150)**, additional airline charges, or the cost of reissuing a new ticket shall be borne by the passenger.

Flight Changes

Flight schedule changes or cancellations made by the airline are beyond our control. Any additional expenses resulting from such changes (including extended layovers, rebooking fees, or additional accommodation costs) shall be borne by the passenger.

◆ BAGGAGE POLICY

- **International Flights:** Each passenger is entitled to **20kg of checked baggage** (either one or two pieces, subject to the airline's regulations) plus **7kg of carry-on** baggage.
- **Domestic Flights:** **Only one** piece of checked baggage is included. Any excess baggage charges must be borne by the passenger.
- It is recommended that each passenger's total baggage weight does not exceed 20kg.
- Passengers are responsible for handling their own luggage throughout the journey. Porter service is not included in this itinerary.
