• Itinerary

Day 1 Arrival in Taipei

Arrive at Taoyuan Airport and transfer to your hotel in Taipei. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure and explore the city at your own pace.

Accommodation: Taipei Riverview Hotel or similar (4★)

Day 2 Taipei

Visit **Shifen Old Street** and the famous **Shifen Waterfall**, often called Taiwan's "Little Niagara." Continue to the charming hillside town of **Jiufen**, known for its lantern-lit streets and tea houses. Later, visit **Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall** and explore **Taipei Underground Mall** before heading to the lively **Ximending Shopping District**.

Accommodation: Taipei Riverview Hotel or similar (4★)

Day 3 Taoyuan / Taichung

Visit the **Taoyuan Rail Vision Museum** and enjoy a unique **train conductor experience**. Continue to **Beipu Old Street**, famous for its Hakka heritage and local

snacks. Travel to Taichung and visit the beautiful **Zhongshe Flower Market**, known for its colorful seasonal flower gardens.

Accommodation: Taichung Inhouse Hotel or similar (4★)

Day 4 Kaohsiung

Travel to Kaohsiung and visit the impressive **Fo Guang Shan Buddha Museum**, one of Taiwan's most important Buddhist sites. Continue to **E-Da Theme Park** and **E-Da Outlet Mall** for entertainment and shopping, before exploring the vibrant **123 Night Market** in the evening.

Accommodation: E-Da Skylark Hotel or similar (5★)

Day 5 Nantou

Visit the scenic **Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area**, Taiwan's largest freshwater lake. Stop at **Wenwu Temple** and **Xiangshan Visitor Center** for panoramic lake views, then visit **Puli Winery**. In the evening, relax in a traditional **hot spring resort** and enjoy the famous "Beauty Hot Spring" experience (swimsuit and swim cap required).

Accommodation: Peikong Greek Resort or similar (4★)

Day 6 Taichung

Visit **Qingjing Farm** and enjoy the popular **Green Green Grassland Sheep Show** set against beautiful mountain scenery. Continue to **Rainbow Village**, famous for its colorful murals, and **Miyahara**, one of Taichung's most iconic heritage buildings. In the evening, explore the lively **Fengjia Night Market**, Taiwan's largest night market.

Accommodation: Taichung Inhouse Hotel or similar (4★)

Day 7 Taipei

Visit a famous **pineapple cake specialty store** before returning to Taipei. Stop at **Taipei 101** (observation deck at own expense) for panoramic city views. Continue to **Wufenpu Shopping District**, Taiwan's largest wholesale fashion market, and finish the day at the popular **Raohe Night Market**.

Accommodation: Taipei Capital Hotel or similar (4★)

Day 8 Departure

Transfer to the airport according to your flight schedule. End of the journey and return home.

Price Includes

1. **Accommodation:** 4-star hotels throughout the tour based on twin-sharing occupancy; **single supplement: USD 300 per person.**
2. **Meals:** All meals are at your own arrangement.
3. **Entrance Tickets:** Admission to **Shifen Waterfall, E-Da Theme Park, and Qingjing Farm.**
4. **Transportation:** Vehicle arrangement as specified above.

◆ METHODS OF PAYMENT

To proceed with reservations, a deposit is required. All services remain subject to availability until payment is received and confirmations are completed.

Booking & Payment Terms

Explore2Go Travels offers a **three-instalment payment** plan as outlined below:

1. **Deposit – 50% per person**

A deposit of 50% per person is required at the time of booking to secure the arrangements.

2. **Second Payment – 30%**

30% of the total package price is payable within one (1) week after the airline tickets have been issued.

3. **Final Balance – 20%**

The remaining 20% must be paid no later than seven (7) days prior to the departure date.

All bookings will be confirmed upon receipt of the required payments. Payment deadlines must be observed to ensure all services remain secured.

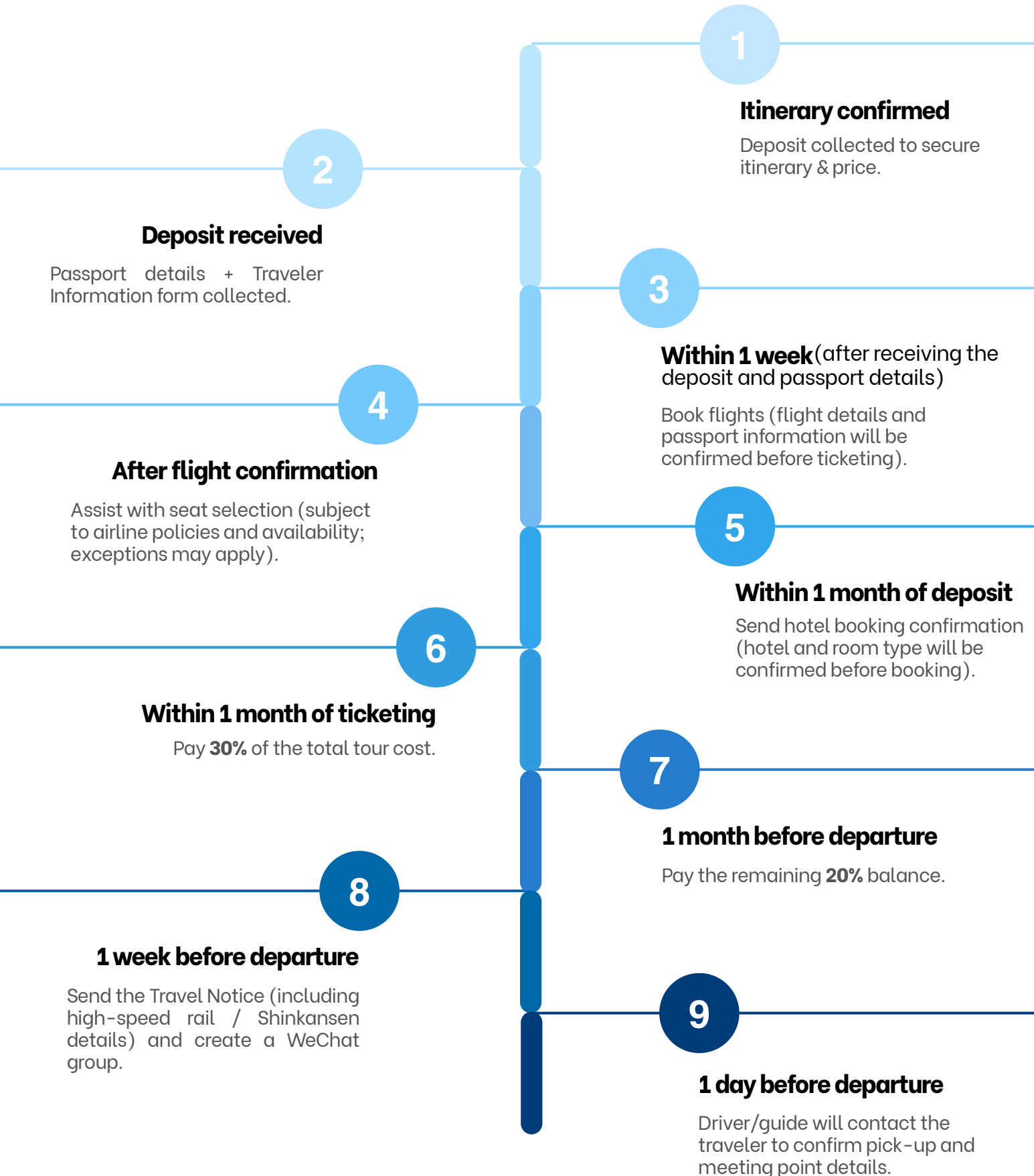
Cancellation & Amendment Policy

- We offer a flexible cancellation and amendment policy.
- For China itineraries, once the hotel reservation has been confirmed, a cancellation will incur a 30% charge of the total amount paid as a cancellation fee.
- Flight tickets will follow the airline's actual cancellation and change policies. Any difference will be refunded or charged accordingly.
- High-speed train tickets: If cancelled more than 8 days before departure, no cancellation fee will be charged. Cancellations within 8 days of departure will follow the official railway refund policy. (Hong Kong routes excluded).
- Cancellations made within 1 month prior to departure are non-refundable. (Except for train and flight tickets which will be refunded according to the applicable cancellation policies.)

◆ BOOKING & SERVICE PROCESS

If the departure date is **within 6 months**, the following process will apply.

If the departure date is **more than 6 months** away, we will update and confirm arrangements in stages based on the booking windows for flights and hotels.



◆ AIRFARE & FLIGHT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Airline Selection

Flights will be arranged based on the overall itinerary and pricing considerations.

The selected airline may be either a full-service carrier or a low-cost carrier. If you have specific requests such as a preferred airline, upgrade to Premium Economy or Business Class, or seat selection, we will make every effort to accommodate your request; however, all arrangements are subject to final confirmation by the airline.

Flights may not be direct and may include up to two (2) stopovers.

Ticket Cancellation & Amendment Policy

Once issued, air tickets are non-refundable.

Any changes to the itinerary must comply with the airline's regulations, and any applicable fees charged by the airline must be borne by the passenger.

Passenger Information

Please ensure that all passenger names exactly match the passport, including all middle names.

If any name correction is required due to incorrect information provided, any **applicable name change fee (AUD 150)**, additional airline charges, or the cost of reissuing a new ticket shall be borne by the passenger.

Flight Changes

Flight schedule changes or cancellations made by the airline are beyond our control. Any additional expenses resulting from such changes (including extended layovers, rebooking fees, or additional accommodation costs) shall be borne by the passenger.

◆ BAGGAGE POLICY

- **International Flights:** Each passenger is entitled to **20kg of checked baggage** (either one or two pieces, subject to the airline's regulations) plus **7kg of carry-on** baggage.
- **Domestic Flights:** **Only one** piece of checked baggage is included. Any excess baggage charges must be borne by the passenger.
- It is recommended that each passenger's total baggage weight does not exceed 20kg.
- Passengers are responsible for handling their own luggage throughout the journey. Porter service is not included in this itinerary.
